**Description:** Four apples grafted onto one tree from the following varieties: Lodi, McIntosh, Red Delicious, Transparent, Lobo, Liberty, or Cortland.  
**Harvest:** Varies  
**Height:** 15'  
**Width:** 15'  
**Zone:** 4

**Cortland**



**Description:** Large red fruit with flavorful sweet-tart white flesh. Good cooking, cider, and desert apple. Vigorous grower and productive tree.  
**Harvest:** Late September  
**Height:** 15'  
**Width:** 15'  
**Zone:** 3

**Earligold**



**Description:** Medium, yellow-green fruit with sweet-tart flavor and crisp flesh. Good for cooking or eating fresh.  
**Harvest:** Early August  
**Height:** 15'  
**Width:** 15'  
**Zone:** 4

**Empire**



**Description:** Red fruit with exceptional flavor. Very crisp and juicy.  
**Harvest:** Mid August  
**Height:** 15'  
**Width:** 15'  
**Zone:** 4

**Freedom**



**Description:** Green & red fruit that is juicy and crisp. Newer variety which is very disease resistant.  
**Harvest:** Late September  
**Height:** 15'  
**Width:** 15'  
**Zone:** 3

**Golden Delicious**



**Description:** Large yellow fruit with crisp, sweet flesh. Excellent desert apple. Requires thinning for good production. Plant in a protected area.  
**Harvest:** Early October  
**Height:** 15'

**Golden Russet**



**Description:** Medium sized fruit with golden brown skin. Firm, crisp texture and unique flavor. Excellent for eating fresh, as well as one of the best choices for cider. Stores very well. Has biennial fruiting habit. (Heavy one year, light the next).  
**Harvest:** Mid October  
**Height:** 15'

**Honeycrisp**



**Description:** Newer apple with extraordinary sweet, crisp, and juicy flesh. Abundant large red fruit. Vigorous tree and reliable producer.  
**Harvest:** Mid September

**Lobo**



**Description:** Large, bright red fruit, with crisp, sweet flesh. Good desert apple. Heavy producer which benefits from thinning.  
**Harvest:** Early September  
**Height:** 15'

**Lodi**



**Description:** Medium sized green-yellow fruit. White flesh is tender, soft, and juicy. Excellent for pies and sauce.  
**Harvest:** Mid-August  
**Height:** 15'  
**Width:** 15'  
**Zone:** 2

### McIntosh



**Description:** Medium sized red & green fruit with crisp, juicy white flesh. Good desert apple.  
**Harvest:** Mid September  
**Height:** 15'  
**Width:** 15'  
**Zone:** 3

### Melba



**Description:** Red flavorful fruit. Good for cooking as well as eating fresh.  
**Harvest:** Mid August  
**Height:** 15'  
**Width:** 15'  
**Zone:** 3

### Mutsu



**Description:** Large greenish-yellow apple. Good for cooking or eating fresh. Not recommended as a pollinator.  
**Harvest:** Mid October  
**Height:** 15'  
**Width:** 15'  
**Zone:** 5

### New Brunswick



**Description:** Summer apple noted for its aromatic fragrance. Skin is an uneven, red on cream background. Used for cooking, it is one of the best apples for jelly. Introduced by Frances P. Sharp in Woodstock NB.  
**Harvest:** Mid August  
**Height:** 15'

### Northern Spy



**Description:** One of the best old fashioned varieties. Mainly a cooking apple but also good for eating fresh. Keeps very well.  
**Harvest:** Early October  
**Height:** 15'

### Priscilla



**Description:** Medium sized, conical fruit with bright red, blush over red background. Good flavor and quality. Slightly tart. Very disease resistant.  
**Harvest:** Mid September  
**Height:** 15'  
**Width:** 15'  
**Zone:** 3

### Redfree



**Description:** Medium, bright red fruit, over yellow background. Creamy white flesh with good flavor. Firm and juicy, it is considered a desert quality apple. Disease Resistant  
**Harvest:** Mid August  
**Height:** 15'

**Zone:** 3

### Royal Gala



**Description:** Medium size fruit is red, very firm, and sweet. Stores well for 6-8 months.  
**Harvest:** Mid September  
**Height:** 15'  
**Width:** 15'  
**Zone:** 4

### Shamrock



**Description:** Green Fruit. Excellent quality. Hardy substitute for Granny Smith.  
**Harvest:** Late September  
**Height:** 15'  
**Width:** 15'  
**Zone:** 4

### Spartan



**Description:** Medium sized fruit with a uniform, dark red blush. Fruit has a firm sweet flesh and stores well. Good desert and baking apple. Vigorous and benefits from thinning. Good scab resistance.  
**Harvest:** Early October  
**Height:** 15'  
**Width:** 15'  
**Zone:** 4

### Transparent



**Description:** Imported from Russia in 1870, it is known as the August apple. Clear yellow fruit has a tender meaty flesh. It is a favorite for pies and sauce.  
**Harvest:** Early August  
**Height:** 15'  
**Width:** 15'  
**Zone:** 3

### Wealthy



**Description:** Medium sized green & red apple with crisp, tart flesh. Good desert or baking apple. Has biennial fruiting habit. (Heavy one year, light the next).  
**Harvest:** Mid September  
**Height:** 15'  
**Width:** 15'  
**Zone:** 4

### **Wolf River**



**Description:** Very large red fruit.  
Exclusively a cooking apple.  
**Harvest:** Early October  
**Height:** 15'  
**Width:** 15'  
**Zone:** 3

**Note:** When choosing a pollinator, it is important to choose varieties that bloom at the same time.  
For example, an early apple would not be a good pollinator for a late apple, but would pollinate a midseason apple.
