Description: Large, firm, juicy black fruit. One of the best known varieties. Requires a pollinator.
Type: Sweet
Harvest: Mid July
Height: 20'
Width: 15'
Zone: 5

Carmine Jewel



Description: Very dark red fruit which is high in sugar content. Great for making juices and wines. Self pollinating.
Type: Sour
Harvest: Early August
Height: 6'
Width: 6'
Zone: 2b

Cavalier



Description: Sweet black fruit. One of the hardier sweet cherries.
Type: Sweet
Harvest: Mid July
Height: 20'
Width: 15'
Zone: 5

Crimson Passion



Description: Large, dark red fruit that has the highest sugar content of all sour cherries.
Type: Sour
Harvest: Early August
Height: 6'
Width: 6'
Zone: 3b

Juliet



Description: Dark red fruit. Excellent for baking and eating fresh.
Type: Sour
Harvest: Early August
Height: 6'
Width: 6'
Zone: 3

Lapins



Description: Very large, firm, dark red fruit. A vigorous and productive tree with an upright habit. Self pollinating.
Type: Sweet
Harvest: Late July
Height: 20'
Width: 15'
Zone: 4

Montmorency



Description: Large bright red fruit, with a firm texture. The most widely planted sour cherry. Used for preserving and baking. Self pollinating.
Type: Sour
Harvest: Late July
Height: 13'
Width: 10'
Zone: 3

Romeo



Description: Small, sweet, dark red fruit. Great for eating fresh or making juice. Self pollinating.
Type: Sour
Harvest: Late August
Height: 6'
Width: 5'
Zone: 3

Stella



Description: Very large, firm, black fruit on a naturally dwarf tree. Resists cracking. Self pollinating.
Type: Sweet
Harvest: Late July
Height: 12'
Width: 10'
Zone: 5

Van



Description: Large, firm, black fruit with good flavor. A heavy producer and good pollinator. Hardier than Bing.
Type: Sweet
Harvest: Early August
Height: 20'
Width: 15'
Zone: 5

Note: Sour cherries do not pollinate sweet cherries.
