OAK *Quercus rubra*

Description: A fast growing oak with deeply lobed, green leaves that turn a nice red in the fall under the right conditions, brown under less than perfect conditions. Produces acorns with a cap on them. Deep spreading roots. Likes full sun. Not fussy about soil.

Height: 18m
Zone: 3

Ohio Buckeye



BUCKEYE *Aesculus glabra*

Description: Similar to the horse chestnut but smaller. Bears green palmate, compound leaves and produces large upright panicles of greenish-yellow flowers. These are followed by inedible nut-like fruit, enclosed in a curious looking prickly husk. Attracts wildlife.

Lorbergii



PEASHRUB *Caragana arborescens 'Lorbergii'*

Description: Very delicate looking, finely cut leaves, almost fern-like in appearance. Yellow pea-like flowers dangle from the branches in spring. Foliage turns yellow in the fall. Great specimen tree.

WEeping PEASHRUB *Caragana arborescens 'Pendula'*

Description: A very tough and durable tree with a strong weeping habit. Features delicate green leaves and yellow pea-like flowers in spring. Provides nice winter interest.

CALLERY PEAR *Pyrus calleryana 'Redspire'*

Description: Highly ornamental broad tree smothered in white flowers with purple anthers in spring, glossy green heart-shaped foliage in summer and fabulous crimson foliage in the fall. Produces small yellow fruit.

Height: 13m
Zone: 5

POPLAR *Populus 'Miracle'*

Description: Poplars are noted for their fast rate of growth, making them an excellent choice for privacy screening. Poplars are characterized by their smooth bark and shiny green leaves.

Height: 15m
Zone: 2

SERVICEBERRY *Amelanchier canadensis*

Description: A rounded, upright tree with an irregular outline. Produces showy clusters of white flowers in spring followed by edible berries which are quickly eaten by birds. Excellent fall color in shades of yellow, orange, and dull red.

SERVICEBERRY *Amelanchier x grandiflora*

Description: Known for its yellow flower buds. Covered with white flowers in spring and produces bluish-purple berries in the fall which make excellent jams and jellies. Fine toothed oval leaves turn a brilliant orange-red color in the fall.

Height: 8m
Zone: 4

WALNUT *Juglans nigra*

Description: A tree prized for its nuts. It needs well-drained soil with a pH of 6-7. The roots of the walnut produce a substance called juglone which inhibits many other species of plants from being able to grow in its vicinity. Beautiful yellow fall color.

Arctic Blue Weeping



WILLOW *Salix purpurea 'Pendula'*

Description: A grafted weeping form with fine, wispy, purple-gray branches. Long, narrow blue green leaves appear after the catkins in early spring. Foliage turns yellow in the fall.

Height: 2.5m
Zone: 3

Dappled Std.



WILLOW *Salix integra 'Hakura Nishiki'*

Description: Tree form with a rounded head. New leaves emerge translucent white with pink and green. As they age the pink is lost. New branches have a burgundy-red color to them in winter. Best leaf and twig color is achieved with annual pruning.

Height: 1.75m
Zone: 4

Golden Weeping



WILLOW *Salix alba 'Tristis'*

Description: A fast grower with graceful arching branches which likes moist soils. Has narrow, pale green leaves with silvery undersides. The golden stems provide winter interest. Produces 3-5" catkins in early spring.

Height: 15m
Zone: 4

Prairie Cascade



WILLOW *Salix babylonica*

Description: A shorter and very hardy variety with glossy green leaves and arching golden branches. A dense and rounded form which prefers to grow in wet conditions. It can even tolerate short periods of standing water. Yellow color in fall.

Height: 10m
Zone: 3

Weeping Pussy



WILLOW *Salix caprea 'Pendula'*

Description: Beautiful specimen which is small enough to fit anywhere. In spring, the long pendulous branches are covered in silver catkins or "pussy willows", after which the dark green leaves appear. Likes full sun and wetter soils. Tidy and compact habit.

Height: 2m
Zone: 4

Arnold Promise



WITCH HAZEL *Hamamelis x intermedia*

Description: An upright, vase-shaped shrub with large, oval leaves. It is noted for its sweetly fragrant, yellow, spider-like flowers which appear in spring before the foliage. Leaves turn yellow in the fall.

Height: 4.5m

Zone: 6
